Mount Baldy has been a site of pilgrimage for The Aetherius Society since August 9th, 1959. It was on this date that the founder of this spiritual and metaphysical organization, Western Master of Yoga Dr. George King, was used as a channel for highly potentized cosmic energies to be placed into the mountain for humanity’s use. The first World Peace Pilgrimage was held on the 50th anniversary of this date in 2009.
